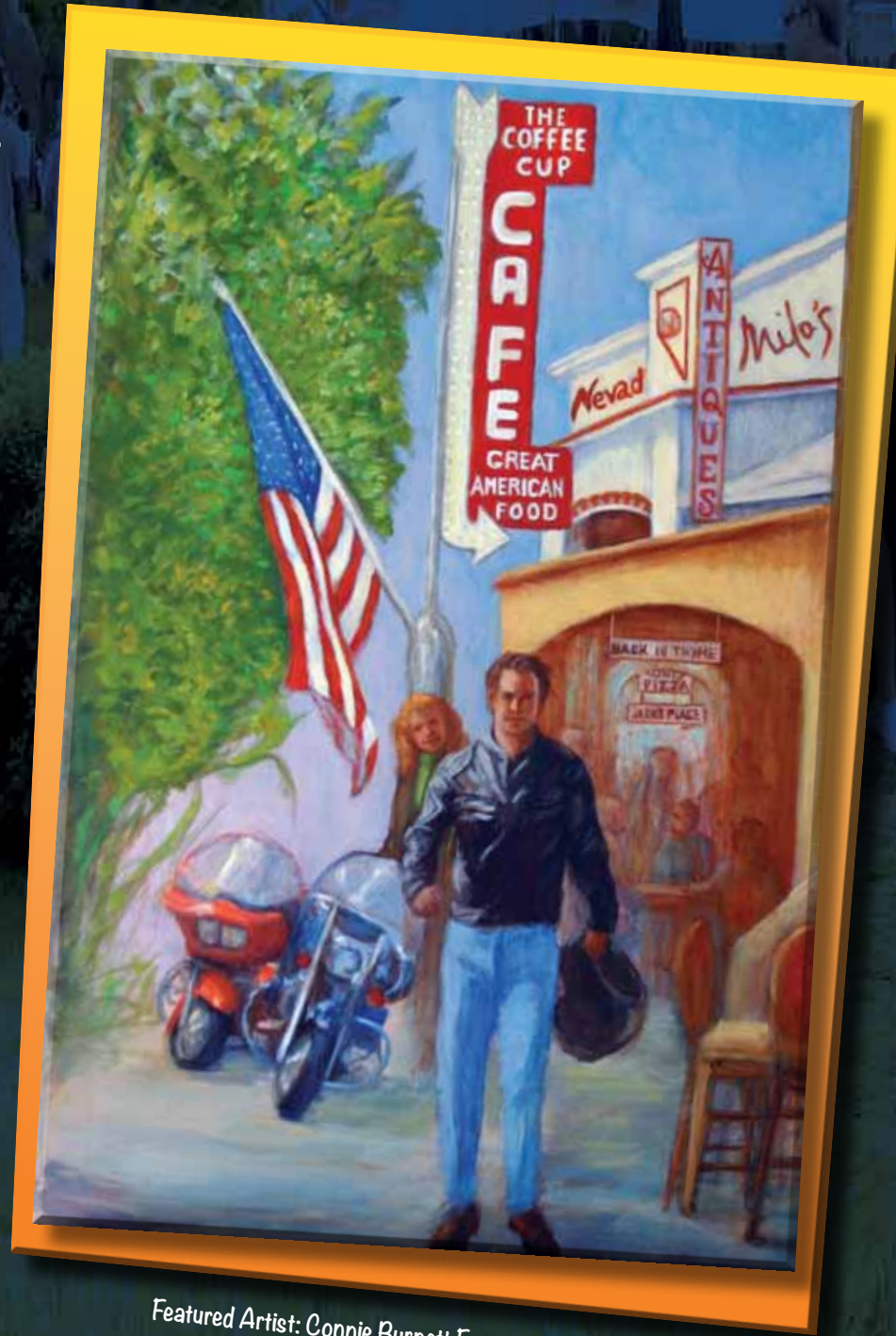

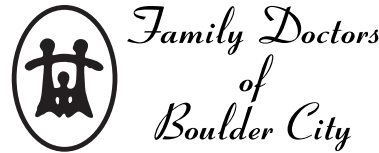

Southwest's Largest Juried Outdoor Art Festival is a Time-Honored Boulder City Tradition

For many Southern Nevadans, a treasured indication that Fall is officially on the way appears as temperatures start to lower, days get a bit shorter and the beloved Boulder City Art in the Park makes its appearance the first weekend of October. Not only is it an art lovers dream come true, it's the 52nd Anniversary of this signature fund-raising event by the Boulder City Hospital Foundation with all proceeds going directly to the hospital and underlines its mission to provide the community with quality health care close to home.

The annual event, which draws up to 100,000 visitors, is comprised of a varied and exciting range of artists, craftsmen, culinary delights and live entertainment. It is widely recognized as the largest outdoor juried art festival in the Southwest! This year's event features hundreds of artisans spread throughout the heart of Boulder city amongst its four beautiful parks. It's simply amazing that the Boulder City community has spent the past half century ensuring its residents are provided with superior health care and it all started from humble beginnings in 1962.

Reaching way back to the 1930's when Hoover Dam was a project guided by the WPA, thousands of workers descended upon the area to build one of the major marvels of the world at the

time. Due to the strenuous (and often times dangerous) work involved, the Government set up a facility to treat the workers and their families associated with the project.

As the early 50's rolled around, and with the project long done, it was decided by the government to close the facility. When the residents of this quaint, beautiful town heard the news it sent them into a grassroots mode with the sole aim of saving the Hospital and establishing a non-profit resource for its residents. Through hard work and innovative thinking the Women's Hospital Auxiliary organized the first Art in the Park event in 1962 in Ralph and Sarah Denton's back yard to go along with other fund raising events held throughout the year.

As one of the city's largest events, Art in the Park wouldn't be successful without the combined efforts of members of our communities. It is the hard work of the Hospital Auxiliary, Hospital staff, Boulder City Chamber of Commerce, Boulder City Police and Fire Departments, Boulder City Parks and Recreation and the City of Boulder City, who make this festival successful. Everyone who can help comes out to set up the area days before the show. Countless hours of setting up booths, registering hundreds of artist and being sure that every little detail is covered

are managed by volunteers from in and around the community.

Fine and traditional art, fine and traditional crafts can all be found at this spectacular event. Guests shop till they drop then gain refreshment at any number of food and beverage booths. Art in the Park always features a variety of food choices from hot dogs, hamburgers, roasted corn on the cob, barbecue sandwiches, Italian, Mexican, Greek, Thai and Chinese fare. And then the desserts and treats... funnel cakes, kettle corn, roasted nuts, fruity bars, frozen treats and more.

Entertainment is a standard at Art in the Park. While strolling the parks and viewing artist works, guests are welcomed to relax in the shade at Bicentennial Park with refreshments while enjoying the stage entertainment from Boulder City's traditional gazebo setting.

Since the inception of the festival every talented artist has donated one original piece to the Art in the Park raffle. That tradition continues today, making every raffle prize a "hot treasure!" Raffle tickets are available at the event booth at the west end of Bicentennial Park. Raffle winners will be notified by phone and may pick up their prizes at the event or at the Boulder City Hospital Foundation office.

Connie Burnett Ferraro – Featured Artist



This year's Art in the Park program cover of the "Heart of Boulder City," is the work of featured artist Connie Burnett-Ferraro. (Please note the artist prefers to be referred to as "Connie" in this article.)

Rhythm, flow, and movement are often used to describe the art of dance. For former Broadway dancer, and local Boulder City artist Connie Burnett-Ferraro, those same adjectives express how she feels while painting. Connie also credits her dance background for developing the discipline that is necessary for painting.

After graduating from high school, she headed straight to New York City and became a Broadway and television dancer. She began sketching her fellow dancers in the dressing room while they were waiting to perform, and especially loved doing their portraits. Every spare moment she was not dancing she would walk across Central Park and visit the Metropolitan Museum of Art and savor her favorite artists, including the impressionists and Van Gogh.

On Saturday mornings, before the matinee and evening Broadway musical performances, she began studying drawing at the famed Art Students League of New York. Every time she walked into the school and smelled the oil paint, she felt at home.

Frank Mason, renowned artist and teacher at the Art Students League, became her primary teacher. Mason insisted the students "just paint and keep working." The students knew not to ask questions of Mason as he felt the only way to learn was by doing. Mason would often say, "You will never learn in a 100 years if you ask questions . . . just keep drawing and painting."

Shortly before she retired from dancing, Connie began spending most of her

time studying at the Art Students League. Many famous painters have studied there including: Jackson Pollack, Norman Rockwell, and Georgia O'Keefe. Actor (and fellow artist) Peter Falk, and many other famous New Yorkers, would often be in Connie's classes.

Mason also taught landscape classes in Vermont. This is where Connie found her passion for painting En plein air, a French expression which means "in the open air" and is used to describe the process for painting outdoors.

After living in New York City for 32 years, she moved to Boulder City to be near her mother. In 1994, she married former Boulder City Mayor Robert Ferraro. It was here in Boulder City that she painted her first outdoor mural. A downtown store sponsored a poster contest to depict the history of Boulder City. Connie entered on a whim and won. She jokes that there were only five entries (three from children). She won the contest and received \$200.

The owners planned to hire someone else to paint a mural of her poster image on the outdoor wall of their building. When that plan did not materialize, Connie told the owners, "I will try it!" At the time, she did not know about "gridding the design," or anything about doing murals. She is scared of heights but pushed through that fear and continued to paint on scaffoldings. She painted the entire mural free hand.

After that first mural was completed, she began getting requests from other businesses (and private homeowners) to paint both interior and exterior murals. Connie has painted 40 murals in Southern Nevada.

Connie also paints portraits, landscapes, and still-life. At this time, she is most passionate about painting portraits. She tries to capture the "inner beauty" of each person she paints and has completed many commissioned portraits. Connie describes a feeling of timelessness when she paints: "I feel

that time stops and I am completely in the moment." Her favorite portrait is of her beloved pet cat, Mr. Pumpkin, an orange long-haired cat with lovely green eyes.

Connie comes from a talented family of artists and credits her father for her love of art. He was a self-taught artist whose work was accepted in galleries around the country. Her most meaningful possession is a portrait her father painted of her mother and Connie when she was a young girl. Her brother, Gary Burnett, is also a talented artist.

Connie has been recognized for her visual depiction of Boulder City's history – from the building of Hoover Dam to the present. She has received many local honors and awards. A map of her murals is available from the Chamber of Commerce. Her work permeates Boulder City – inside and out. She has also exhibited her paintings at Ardavin Art Gallery in Atlanta, Georgia; the Salmagundi Club and Greenwich Village Art Show in New York City. She is currently exhibiting her work at the Boulder City Art Guild in the Historic Boulder Dam Hotel. She is the featured artist at Booth #202.

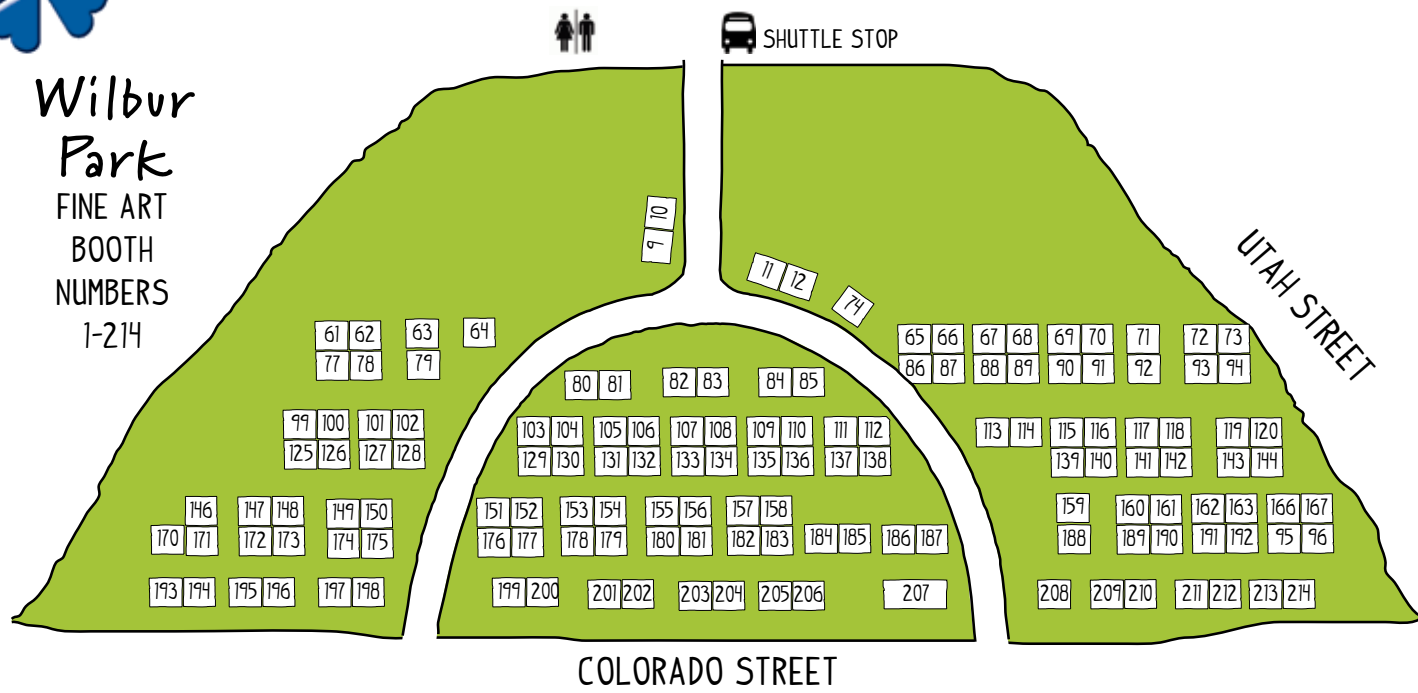

Boulder City Hospital is moving closer to its goal of becoming a full-service "age in place" facility with major expansion and renovation now underway that will better serve our growing senior population while still caring for the needs of Boulder City residents and our valued visitors.

A not-for-profit acute care critical access hospital and skilled nursing facility, the Hospital has achieved the highest scores on all Quality of Care measures for rural hospitals in Nevada while fulfilling its mission to provide patient-centered, compassionate care.



Our hospital also has also achieved among the lowest readmission rates in Nevada, another major quality indicator that means our patients are not discharged until they are ready for discharge. But the most important grade comes from our patients themselves, who give the Hospital an A+ (98%) in patient satisfaction.

Thanks to a loan from USDA Rural Development, the Hospital will be able to serve even more satisfied patients. Phase 1 of the project marked the completion of two brand new programs now available to the community, a 10-Bed inpatient Geriatric Behavioral Medicine Center and a 10-Bed Acute Physical Rehabilitation Unit. 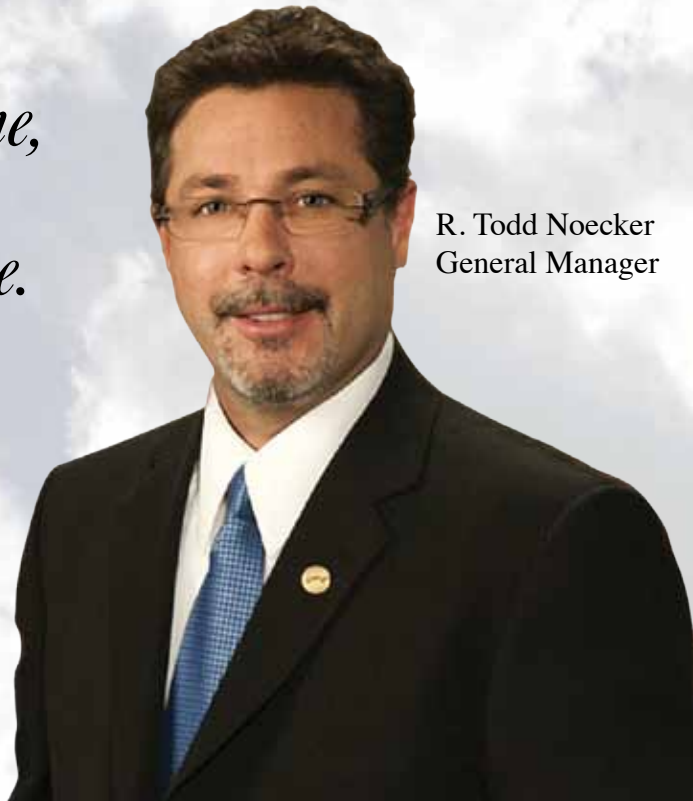
