At the Boulder City Hospital Partial Hospitalization Program, we provide a structured, individualized program and intensive psychiatric care focusing on the specific needs of each client with the goal of increasing one's health related quality of life.

We offer treatment for depression, bipolar disorder, psychosis, severe anxiety and other mood disorders.

The Partial Hospitalization Program is staffed by a multidisciplinary team that includes psychiatrists, marriage and family therapists, social workers, and psychiatric nurses.

Through comprehensive group and individual therapy, clients gain skills necessary to enhance their quality of life and maximize their ability to function independently.

The Boulder City Hospital Partial Hospitalization Program meets the needs of people who are able to remain in the community, but require more specialized and intensified care than traditional outpatient clinics to safely reduce the risk for harm and hospitalization.

The partial hospitalization program provides a supportive environment where clients can gain the skills and resources that will foster independence, self-confidence and self-reliance.
