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# PUBLIC NOTICE

Proposed Conversion to a Rural Emergency Hospital  
Clark County, Nevada

Notice is hereby given that **Boulder City Hospital**, located at **901 Adams Boulevard, Boulder City, Clark County, Nevada**, intends to convert its licensed hospital facility to a **Rural Emergency Hospital (REH)**, subject to approval by the **Director of the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health (DPBH)** and the **Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS)**.

## Description of Proposed Action

Boulder City Hospital proposes to transition from a licensed Critical Access Hospital to a Rural Emergency Hospital. Under the REH model, the facility will continue to provide:

- 24-hour emergency department services
- Observation care
- Outpatient services

Inpatient hospital admissions will no longer be provided at the facility following conversion.

## Purpose and Need

The proposed conversion is intended to preserve access to essential emergency and outpatient healthcare services for residents of Clark County while supporting the long-term financial and operational sustainability of the facility. This action is consistent with the federal Rural Emergency Hospital designation, which was established to support rural and underserved communities experiencing low inpatient utilization and healthcare workforce challenges.

## Impact on Services

- Emergency medical services will remain available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- Patients requiring inpatient hospitalization will be stabilized and transferred to appropriate partnering hospitals within Clark County or surrounding service areas, as clinically indicated.
- No interruption of emergency services is anticipated as a result of this conversion.

## Regulatory Review and County Considerations

Clark County has a population in excess of 100,000. In accordance with **Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 439A.102**, the proposed conversion is subject to review and written approval by the Director of the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health prior to modification of the facility's hospital license.

This conversion is also subject to applicable state licensing requirements and federal certification requirements administered by CMS.
